



The above tract of 284 1/2 Acres of Land was Surveyed by Wm Scull then Deputy on an Application dated the 15th of July 1769 unto Charles Pattison on the 15th day of October 1771 & was said to contⁿ 326 Acr obl. & an obl. ow obl. esurvey is found to contain only two hundred and eighty four & 1/2 Acres & Allowance. The other Land to the North of the dotted line ~~was~~ is part of a tract surveyed to Henry McKinly on the 15th of October 1771 by Wm Scull then Deputy and contains within the metes and bounds above described one hundred and fifteen Acres & an half of Land & the usual allowance which two tracts together make four hundred Acres of Land & Allowance.
