

Cent (it being part of AS 211 3/4 Originally survey'd to Henry Spangler in pursuance of a warrant granted to him dated the third day of June A.D. 1736.) Resurvey'd the above at the request of Philip Klein on the twenty seventh day of December A.D. 1803.
