



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Metal Township Franklin County Pa. Containing 47 Acres 122 perches & allowance surveyed Janry 5th 1842 in pursuance of a warrant granted Adam Snyder dated Augst 31st 1841

The dotted line shows the line of a survey made and was supposed to be vacant by the Warrantee but after going on the ground and making the survey represented by dotted lines and returned from the ground and examined further I found the part marked A to be part of the survey of Benjamin Chambers on warrant dated Janry 29th 1757. But since abandoned by the Warrantee and laid on the part marked by black lines. The part marked B contains about 16 Acres & 26 perches and appears on file to be part of a survey of James Chambers of 200 Acres; but there being no certainty about it I took it in. And the above land is claimed by Gen^l James Chambers's Heirs
