



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 25th April A.D. 1775 surveyed on or about the 5th day of June A.D. 1775 by George Palmer late Deputy Surveyor to Haggai Skinner the above described tract of land situate on the head waters of Corkins Creek in Northampton County (now in Damascus Township Wayne County) Containing 107 Acres 22 Perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. as appears from the field works of George Palmer and as examined and approved by me February 15th A.D. 1871.
