



Draft of a tract of land situate in Hanover township Luzerne County adjoining Robert Lenox and others Containing three hundred ninety eight acres one hundred six perches and allowance of six per cent &c.

Surveyed the 7th day of May 1839 by Zeb. Stephens late Deputy Surveyor for Joseph Slocum by virtue of his warrant dated the 8th day of January 1793 and Certified by me the 19th day of December 1848

N.B. The above Survey is one of a larger body of lands the warrants for which issued in 1793 and a general survey of the whole was made about this time though the Surveys were not returned until 1837 or 1838. Prior to this time a warrant in the name of George W. Woodward was located and returned so as to render it impossible to return the above survey adjacent to Isaac Slocum (the tract called for.) The above named tract was located on vacant land near the place originally called for and adjoining the body of lands to which it belonged
