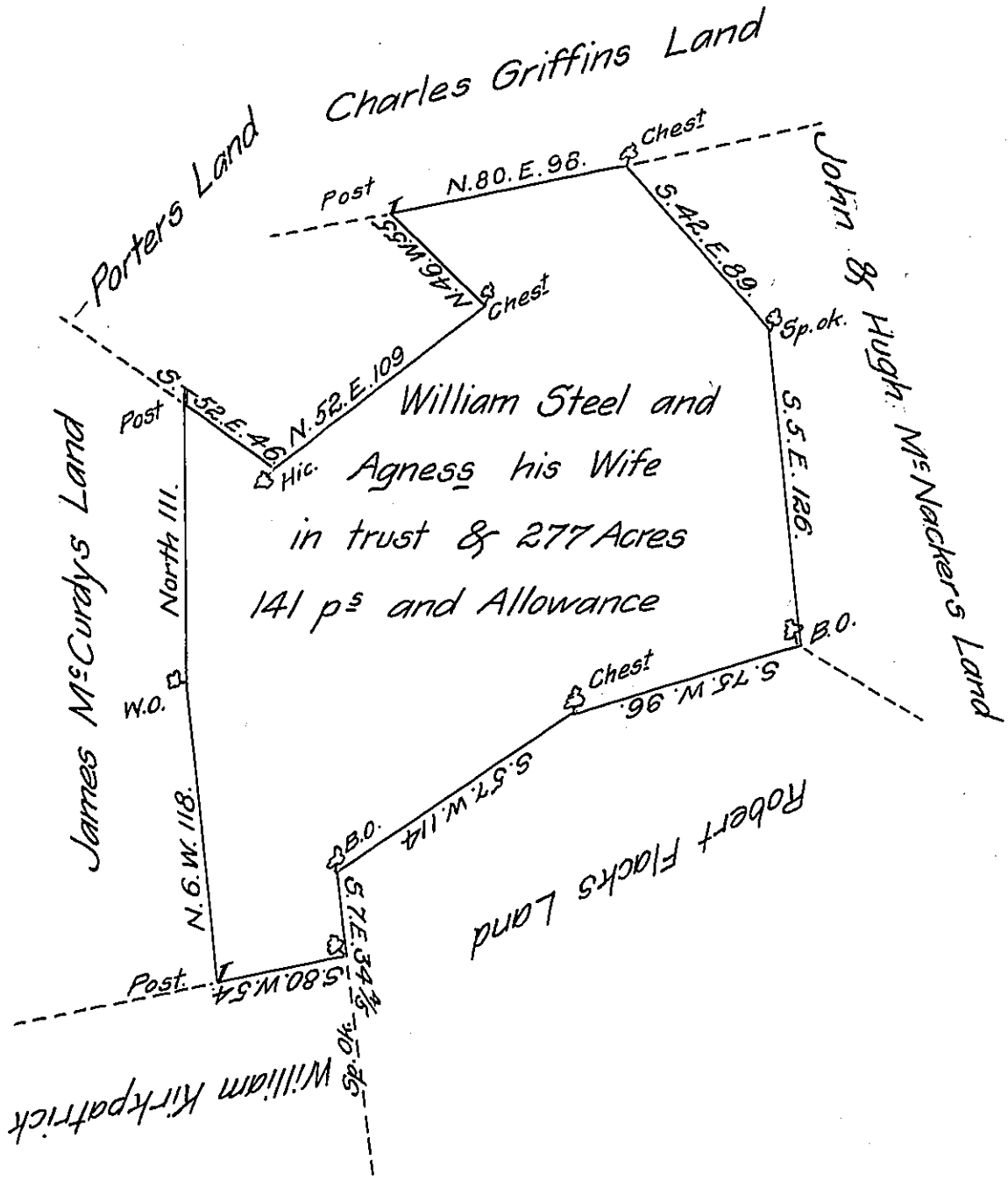


This is the second Return of the above describe Survey sent to the Survey Gen's Office.
