



Situate in Windsor and Chanceford Townships in the County of York Containing as above set forth 6<sup>a</sup> & 133 perches and allowance, being part of a larger Tract of Land Originally Surveyed on the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1789. In Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Casper Sailer bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1787. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of land by William Kersey late deputy surveyor on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the Second Month A.D. 1797. And now at the Request of the Present Owner John Sechrist I am desired to make return of the Draught as Calculated &c. the 2<sup>d</sup> ~~th~~ day of August A. D. 1809.
