



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 13th Day of Nov Anno. 1751⁺ granted to Teeter Siedler the above described Tract of Land Situate in Heidlebergh Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Two hundred and twenty four Acres and 145 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads was Surveyed for the said Teeter Siedler, on the 27th Day of October Anno. 1757.
