Branch of Susquehanna - about three miles above the Mouth of Fishing Creek Called Shumans Island opposite to lands of Said Sherman in Catiwissa Township and lands of Abraham Whitmore in Bloom Township and near the middle of the River and about 40 perches below some other Small Islands. Containing One Acre and forty four Perches Strict Measure. Surveyed unto Jacob Sherman on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1815. by Virtue of his Warrant dated October 28<sup>th</sup> 1815.
