Note. The above described tract of land is included in a Survey, made on the ^{thirty} first day of May 1837, by E. P. Deane Dep. Survr. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Abraham C. Crandall, on the 2^d day of December 1836. The Survey made for A. C. Crandall, interferes with Warrant No. 4487, Jas. Wilson. Warrant, and the above described tract is entirely cut off from the main body of the A. C. Crandall Warrant, by Warrant No. 4487, the last mentioned Warrant being owned by Dan. G. Stevens, who claims that A. C. Crandall or those claiming under said Crandall, cannot hold two separate pieces of land under one Warrant.
