



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres of Land dated the 10th day of April 1793 was surveyed on the 4th day of January 1820 for John Short the above described tract of land containing Four Hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads & C as entered on survey Book page 162 Remaining in my Office it being the same tract first settled by Joseph Mattocks who sold part of the same to Richards State & James Miller who now Resides on the same & having reexamined the same & find the survey to be correct situate in Fallowfield Township Crawford County and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Deputy Surveyors office Meadville Sept. 15th 1825.
