Smith which Appears to have been divided between said parties at the time and the dotted part of 53^{ac} 70^{ac} & Allowance allotted to Abm. Smith which is patented; The other part was Casper Kemps and Contained 109^{ac} 150^{ac} & Allowance which Now On Resurvey Contains One hundred eighteen Acres and eighty eight perches and Allowance Resurveyed for Return the 22 Oct^r 1822
