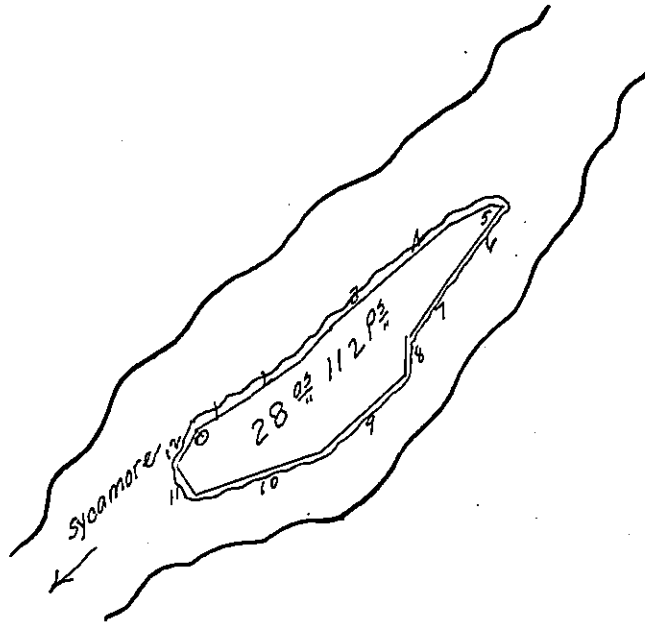

ted 21st September 1820.*
