Containing as above set forth 59 & 60 P & allowance & being part of a larger Tract of 134 & 94 Perches & allowance of Land which was Originally Surveyed by William Mathews late DS on the 4th of the 11th month 1766 for Henry Armen In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100 & Granted to Christian Sangree bearing date the 21st day of May AD 1762 and afterwards Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land for and at the request of Jacob Stabler the present owner who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation as calculated examined and found to be correct the 29th day of February AD 1812.
