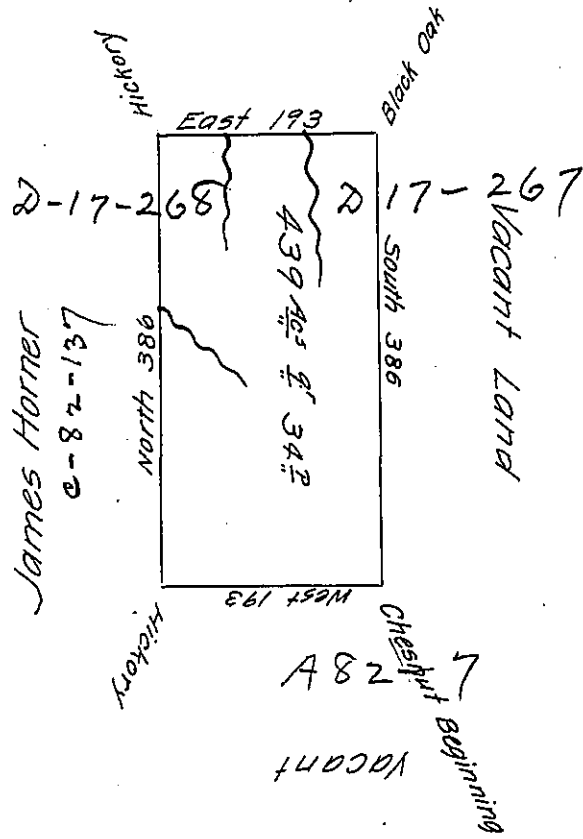

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 23<sup>d</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Josiah Tannehill for 400 Acres of Land Situate adjoining James Horner to the East and on the North Side of the Large Stream which empties into Big Beaver North and West of the River Ohio in District N<sup>o</sup> 9 Called Panther Ridge on the Waters of Beaver Creek Containing four hundred thirty Nine Acres and thirty four poles together with the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads (Date of the aforesaid <sup>warrant</sup> is Feb<sup>y</sup> the 10<sup>th</sup> 1794)
