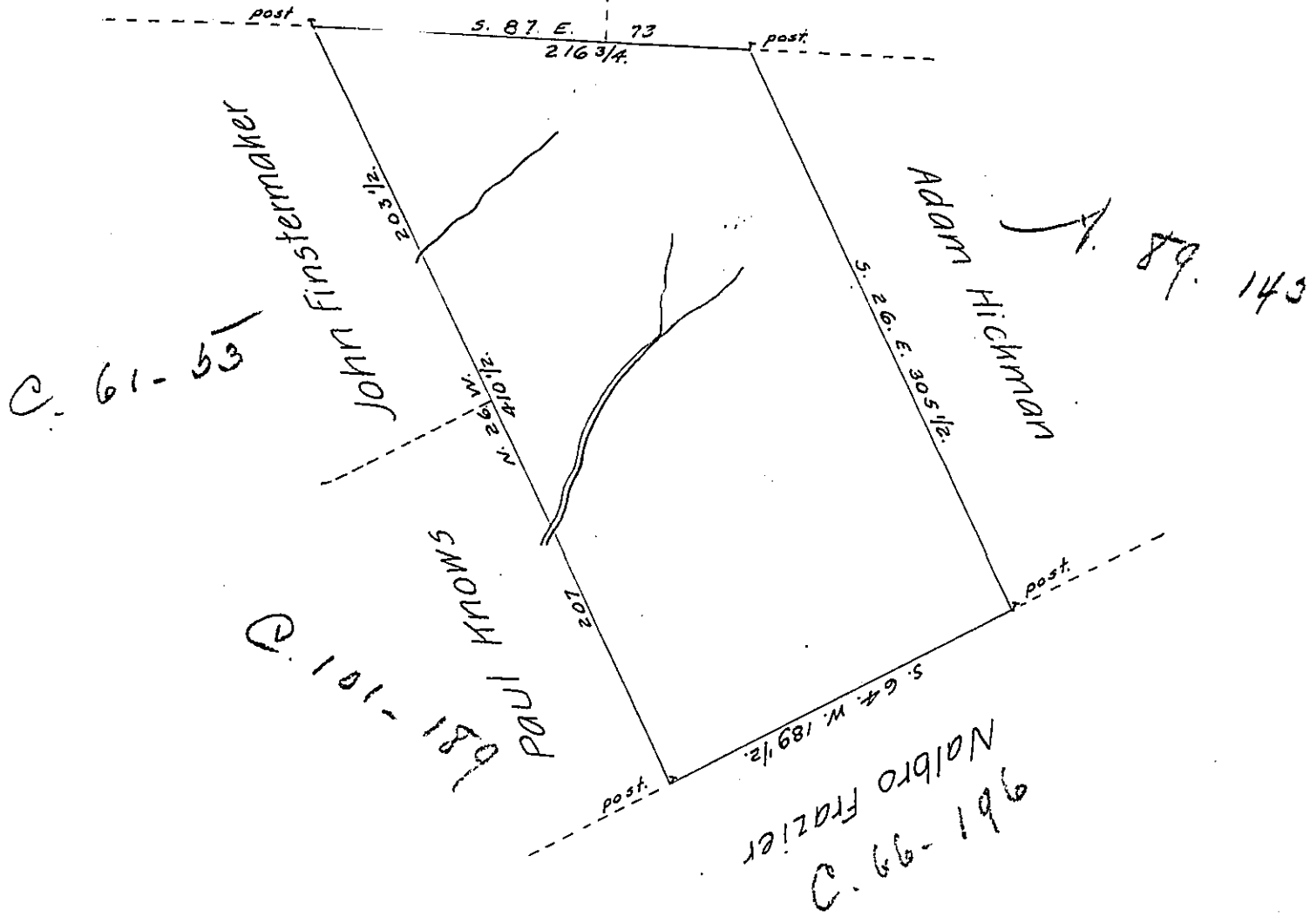


A. 76-7 Vacant land C. 46-98 Michael Cryder
