In Pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey dated the 4th day of ~~June~~ ^{July} 1754. Situate in Philad^a City
 I resurvey^d to William West a Lot of ground on the Bank of Delaware River, between Mulberry Street and Sassafras Street, containing in breadth on Delaware Front Street 14½ feet and in Depth 22 feet & 6 Inches. Bounded Northward with part of a Bank & Water Lot granted to Benjamin Chambers (in right of Alexander Beardsley) by Patent dated the 9th day of June 1694. Eastward with ground now in the Tenure of Anthony Wilkinson. Southward by part of a Bank & Water Lot granted to y^e Said Benjamin Chambers in right of ~~Wm Powell~~ W^m Powell by Patent of y^e 9th of June 1694, and Westward with Front Street Aforesaid. Which described Lot of Ground is part of the two Bank & Water Lots Above Mentioned, vizt 11 feet & 6 Inches on Front Street aforesaid & 22½^{ft} Deep, part thereof is part of the Bank & Water Lot ~~ab~~ ~~are~~ ~~we~~ granted to Benjamin—in right of W^m Powell, & y^e remainder being ^{the 3^d & 22½^{ft} Deep} 3 feet on Front Street is part of y^e Lot above Mentioned granted to B.C. on right Alex: Beardsley.
