



A Plan of a Lot of Ground in the Town of York. No 122. Situate on the South Side of High Street containing in ~~the~~ Breadth on the Said Street Sixty five Feet and in Length to a twenty feet Alley, two hundred & thirty feet, bounded Northward with High Street, Westward with a Lot of Ground No 123. Southward with a twenty feet Alley, and Eastward with a Lot of Ground No 121. Entered on the Plan of the said Town and Survey'd for the said William Willis who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the Town.

Certified at York the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1753.
