



A Draught of a piece of land situate in Warrington Township in the County of York (late part of the County of Lancaster) Containing as above set forth 75<sup>2/3</sup> of 68 perches and allowance &c. Being the same tract of land which was Originally Surveyed on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April A.D. 1749 by Thomas Cookson late D.S. of Lancaster County. in pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>ac</sup> granted to William Smith bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1748. Now on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1838.

Examined & Corrected the above &c. as the work of said Thomas Cookson late D.S. at the request of Thomas Fesse the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation To John Taylor Esquire per D<sup>l</sup> Leese D.S. Surveyor General.
