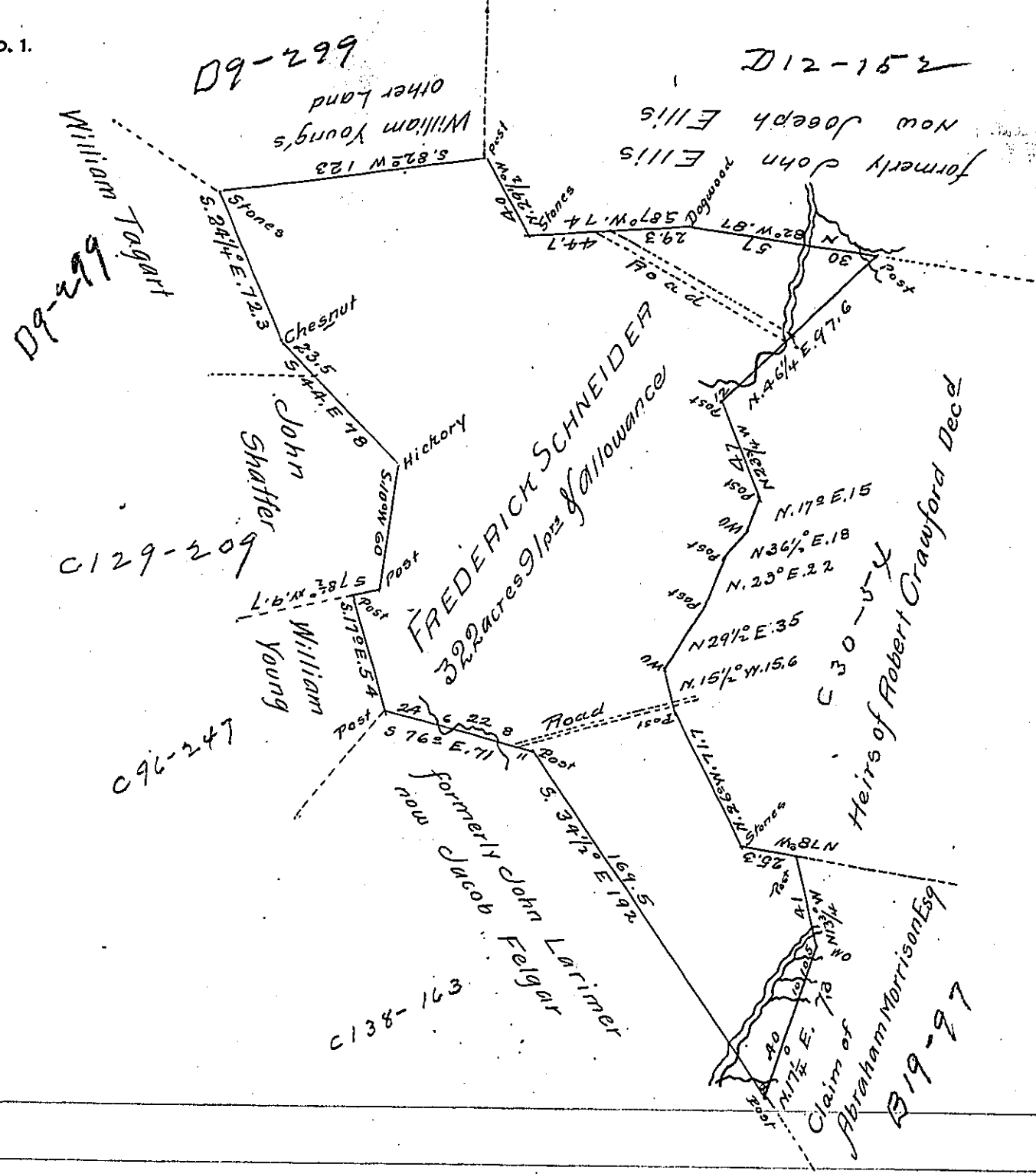


FORM NO. 1.



12th January 1837. Surveyed the above described tract of Land in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Frederick Schneider dated 20th October 1807. Situate on the Waters of Indian Creek (formerly Called Saltlick Creek) and on the waters of White Oak run in Donnegal Township Westmoreland County. Containing Three hundred Twenty two acres Ninety-one perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
