



Situate in Aleghany Township Huntingdon County containing Fifty nine acres One hundred & fifteen perches & the usual allowance of six per Cent for roads &c. being part of a tract originally surveyed in pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to Solomon Singer dated the first of August 1766, No 403 it was then said to contain Three hundred Twenty seven acres One hundred & Twenty p. & c. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 15th day of February 1837. The dotted lines representing the original Survey of Solomon Singer
