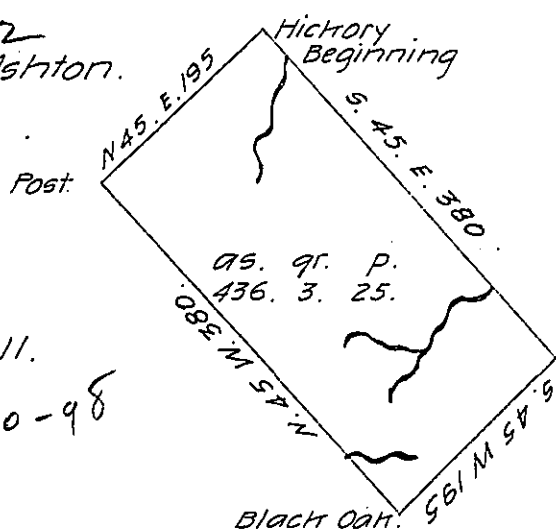

The above is a draught of a Survey made May the 17th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Robison for 400 acres of land dated the tenth day of February 1794 adjoining John Scull to the Eastward and the South side of the Conaquessing Creek North and West of the River Ohio, Alleghany and Conowango Creek Called Sugar Bottom Contain- ing four hundred thirty six acres three quarters and twenty five poles to- gether with the usual allowance of Six P. Cent
