



The draft of a tract of land Called "Susar's Vale" Situate in Greenwood township (late Cumberland, now) Mifflin County, divided May 25th 1792 for James McLin & Hugh Watts. Viz: for James McLin one hundred twenty three acres & 49 perches & the allowance of Six P. Cent for roads &c^a, & for Hugh Watts one hundred eighty two acres 73 perches & allowance afores^d; it being the same tract of three hundred & five acres & seven tenths of an acre & allowance, which appears by a draft from William Maclay late Deputy Survr., to have been by him Surveyed, the 4th of April 1767 for Susannah Crampton, in pursuance of an order of Survey No. 2304 dated the 2d day of January 1767.
