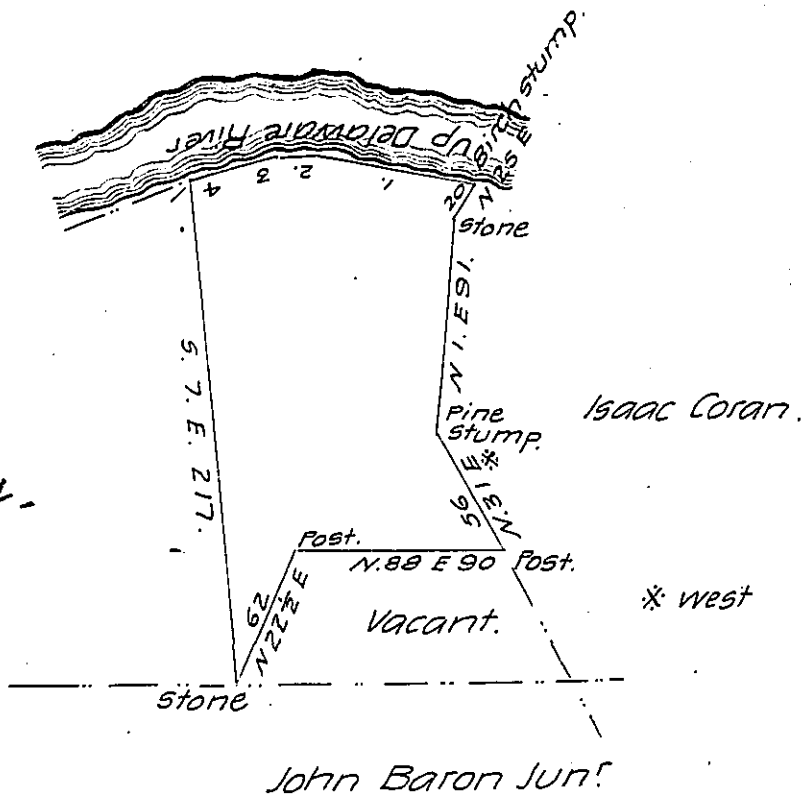

Ct. for Roads &c.
