



I have surveyed the above described land in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Zeri W. Remington (for ten acres) dated the 30th day of October A. D. 1843. Situated in Peebles Township Allegheny County, containing seven acres thirty eight $\frac{2}{10}$ perches and allowance of six per cent. Surveyed Nov. 21, 1843.

Note. The above land is situated between two tracts: One surveyed to Charles Duke the 2d of Feb. 1785 by Benj. Lodge D.S. on a Warrant in the name of William Troop dated the 13th of June 1769. And the other in the name of James Ralph, on a Warrant dated the 3d day of April 1769 & surveyed on the 25th day of October 1769 by William Thompson D.S. Which said two tracts is now in the possession of Henry Woods together with the above described land.
