



By virtue of a warrant dated the 22d day of January 1846, order of Survey recd. the 30th of January 1846 surveyed the 18th of February 1846 to Benjamin H. Rose the above described Tract of Land being unimproved, situate in Westfall Township Pitt County adjoining lands of Rosencrance C. Bull, Benjamin H. Rose, and the River Delaware containing twenty five acres thirty two perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
