



16th March 1833. Surveyed the above piece of land included by drawn lines. Containing one hundred and seven acres and fifty six perches and the usual allowance of six Pr. Ct for Roads & Cr., being part of a larger tract of land Surveyed in pursuance of an application No. 1630 dated 3rd April 1801 Entered by Alexander Barr. situate in what is now Derry township West County Pa. The 107as. 56prs is now claimed by Robert Thompson in right of his wife Jannet one of the heirs of Alexander Barr. The only paper produced to run the lines by, was an old draft signed John Moore D.S. dated 23rd April 1799, which appears to be the time when the property was divided among the heirs, and the original claim referred to
