



In pursuance of an Order No. 1630 dated 3d of April 1769 Survey'd for Alexander Barr the above described tract of land (called Barrs Choice) containing three hundred & fifty one acres & 120 perches, with an allowance proportioned to 6 P. Cent. Situate on a small branch of water leading into Loyalkaning adjoining Wm Joyce, the Dividing Ridge & including his improvement near Wm Guthry in Westmoreland County &c.
