



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 12a & 44 perches and the usual allowance of Six per Cent &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 30a & 68 perches and the allowance of land which was originally surveyed by Moses McClean late D.S. on the 7th day of October A.D. 1789. In pursuance of a Warrant for 40a granted to John Rutysail bearing date the 22d day of December A.D. 1788. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 14th day of December Anno Domini 1815, for and at the request of Michael Miller the present owner, who desired the same to be returned for confirmation
