



Situate in Briar-creek Township. Columbia County (formerly Northumberland) Containing One hundred fourteen Acres and Twenty four perches, and the usual allowance of 6 per cent &c being part of a Survey of two hundred twenty eight acres and forty eight perches and allowance. Originally Surveyed by Henry Donnel D.S. on the 22nd day of April 1806. for Simon Sittler and Evan Owen by Virtue of their Warrant bearing date on the 22nd day of July 1793. and now to Wit on the 27th day of January 1823. the above part containing 114⁹ 24²⁵ & allowance returned for Wesley Bowmand agreeably to a division heretofore made by the said parties.
