(late part of Lancaster County) Containing as above set forth 190<sup>a</sup> and allowance &c. Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1745. by Thomas Cookson late D.S. In Pursuance of a warrant for 150<sup>a</sup> Granted to John Adam Schilig bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1744. And now the above has been Calculated, examined &c and found to be correct and at the request of the owners George Asper and Henry Jacobs, the same is returned for Confirmation the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1811.
