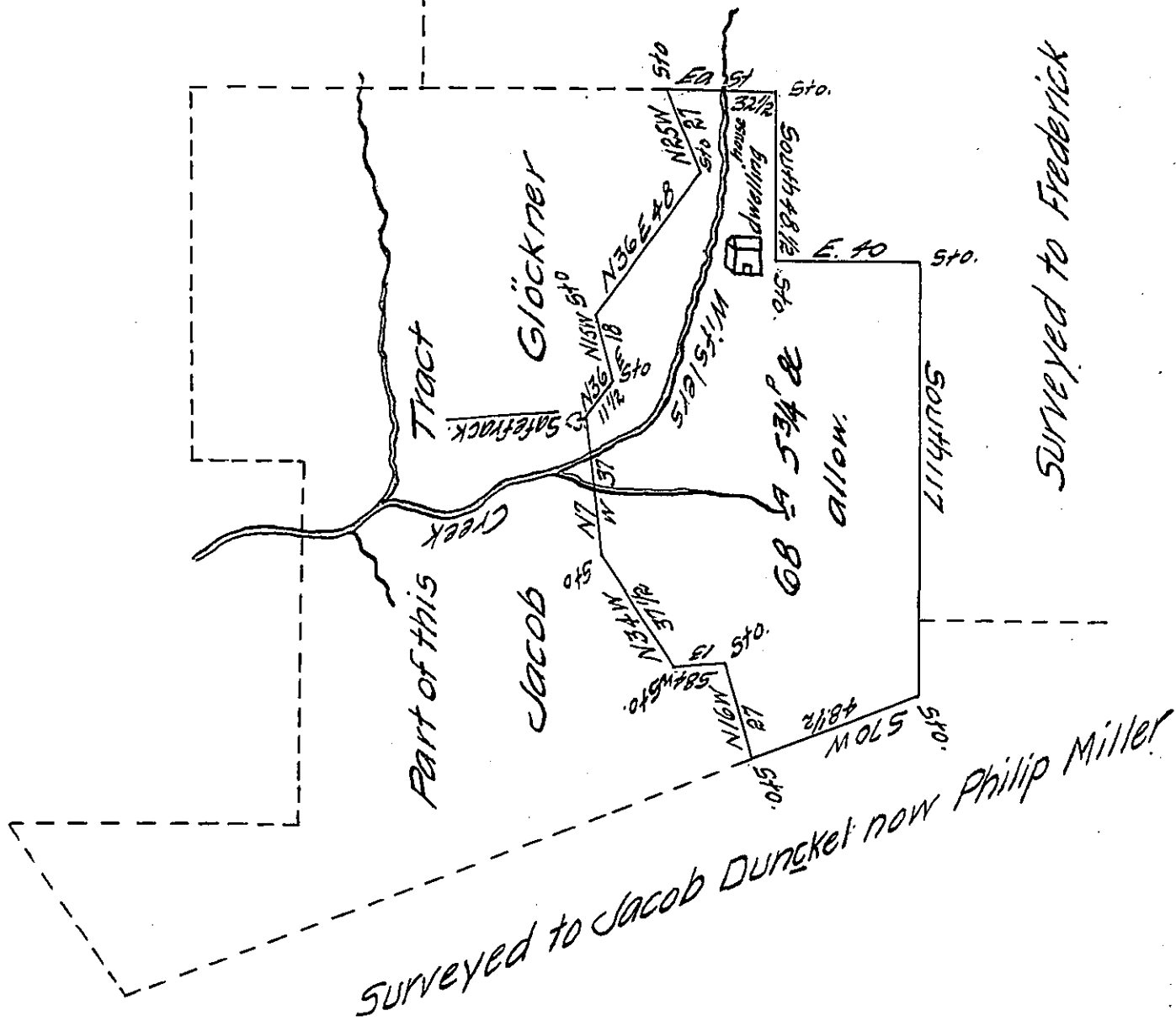

Situate in Brunswieg Township Schuylkill County surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> November. A.D. 1821 to John Glöckner Jnr. It being a part of the same tract of 215-A 35 3/4 P & allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Which was surveyed to the heirs and relations of Andrew Glöckner dec'd by Virtue of a Warrant granted to Michael Stein dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of April A.D. 1785.
