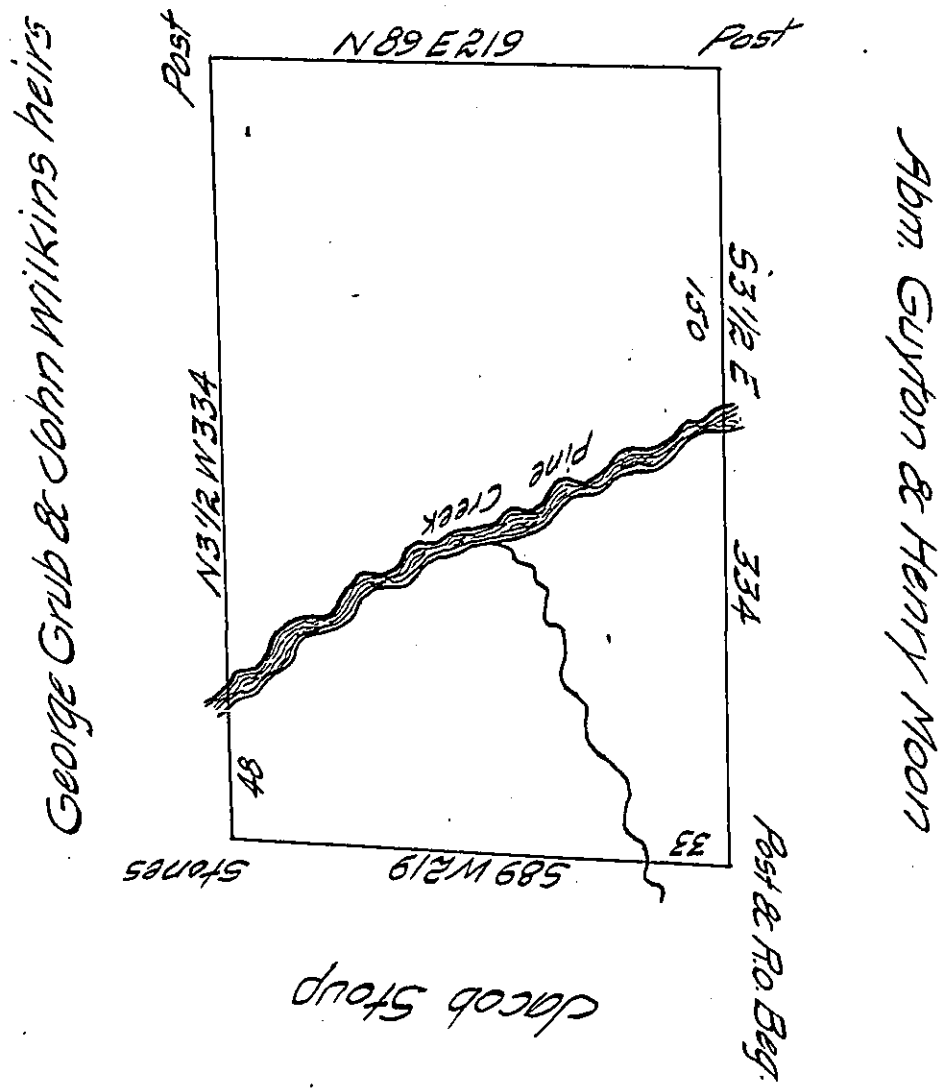

N.B. this Survey was executed by Virtue of Philip
Servers Actual Settlement before he applied for his War^t
Executed on Dec^r 1st 1818 but ret^d as if Executed June 2^d

the time of surveying the above P. Server lived thereon with his
family & had at least 50 acres clear & in a state of Cultivation &c. D. Coon D.S.
