



Situate in Windsor (formerly York) Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth eighty two acres, Sixty two perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. being part of a larger tract of 325 1/2 acres & allowance originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 12th day of April 1752 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Stevenson, dated the 18th day of December A.D. 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, on the 2nd day of May 1822 for Samuel Walbeck, at whose request the same is returned for confirmation.
