



Draught of two hundred Sixty three acres fifty nine perches of land and the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Road &c; Situate in Armagh Township formerly Cumberland now Mifflin County, part of a tract of land called Rapho, which appears Surveyed by Colonel John Armstrong, in pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietors to James Sterrett dated the 4th day of Feb^y 1755— Resurveyed 29th May 1772 by W^m Maclay D.S. agreeable to the old lines Resurveyed & divided 13th & 14th Nov. 1798 by W^m Harris D.S. at the request of James Sterrett &c.

Examined the 21st day of May 1821 at the request of Robert Sterrett the present owner, who wants a Patent therefor.
