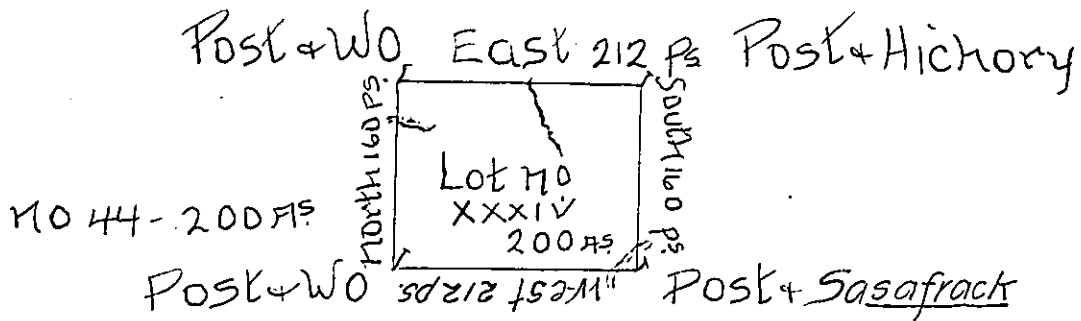

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785 "entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor Genl with the Approbation of the Honorable the Supreme Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 13 day of October 1785 The Above described Tract of Two Hundred acres of land and allowance of six Pcent. for roads & no xxxiv - situate in district no. 1 on the West side of the Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland.
