In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785. the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent for roads & No 1624 situate in District No 8 on the West side of the Alleghany river, in the county of Westmoreland.
