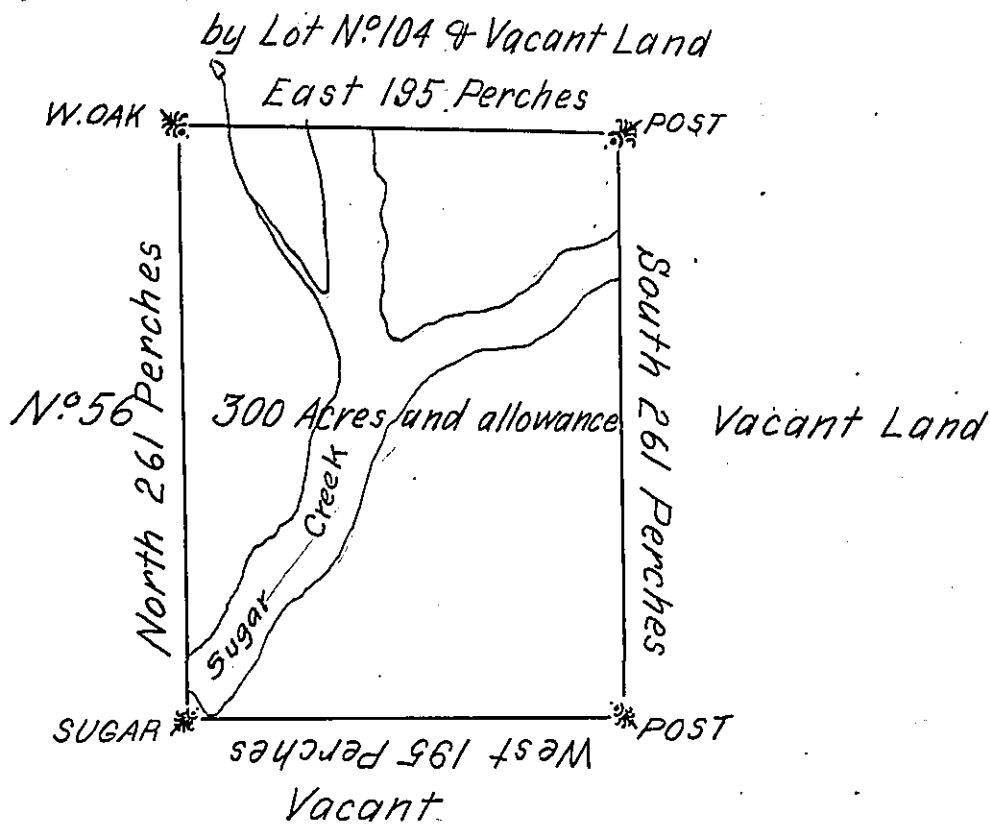


Donation-Land, in District N^o 6.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intituled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honorable Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the Twentieth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Three hundred Acres of Lands and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. N^o 55 situate in District N^o 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
