

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth' and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the twenty eighth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads, &c. Nº 1268 situate in District No.6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
