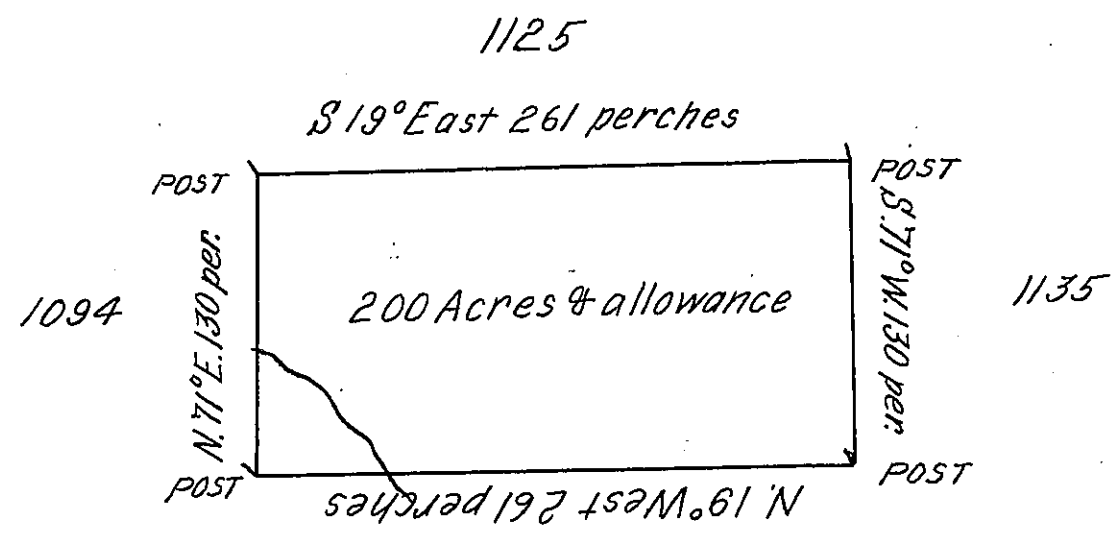

Donation-Land, in District N<sup>o</sup> 6



In pursuance of an Act of Genr<sup>l</sup> assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th Day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor Gener<sup>l</sup> with the approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 9th day of November 1785, the above discribed Tract of two hundred acres and allowance of six p<sup>r</sup> Ct for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> 1126 situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 6, on the West Side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
