



The above is a Draught of one hundred and twenty Acres & 20^r: of Land and Allowance Situated about two miles above the mouth of Fishing Creek on the bank of the River Susquehanna being the Residue and Eastern part of a Tract Surveyed to Lazarus Stewart on an Application 3^d of April 1769 N^o 1010 by me but the western part ^{then} had been previously appropriated to Henry Allshouse who recovered the same - the above has been cut off as remaining to said Stewart on his order June 17th 1801 Certify'd this 20th of March 1802.
