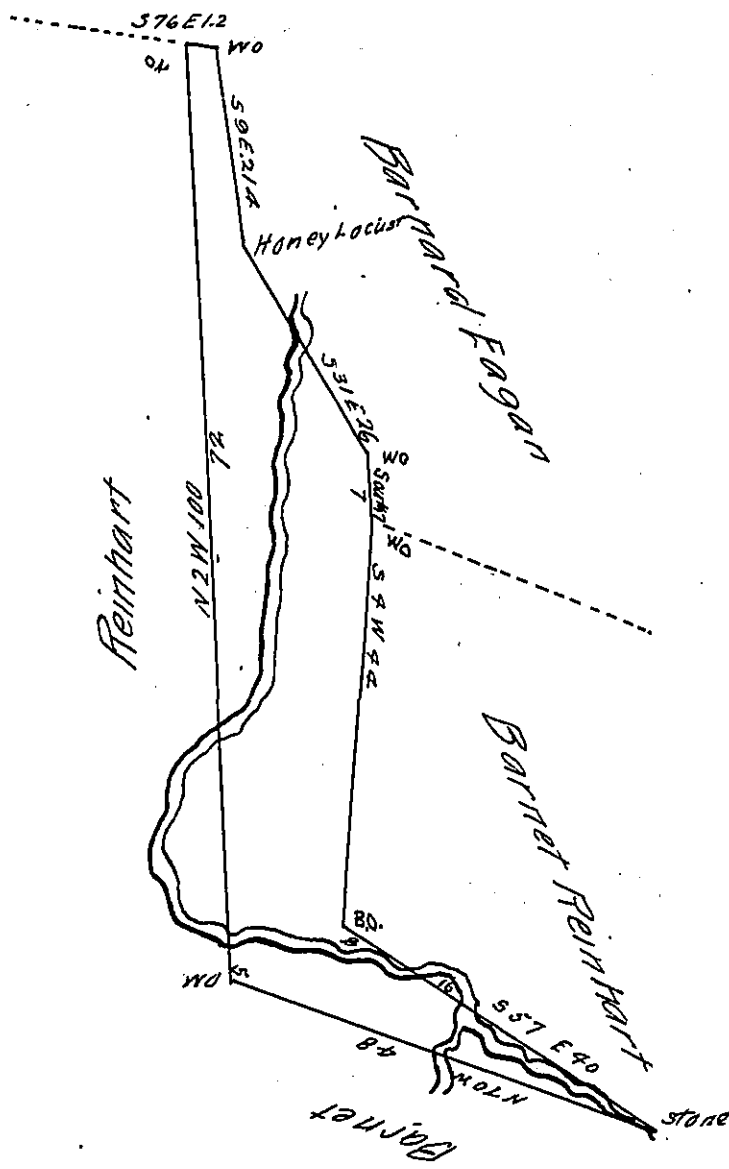


Bernard Fagan



A Draught of survey made 8<sup>th</sup> of May 1822 containing T.A. 40 p. and allowance of six per cent in pursuance of a Warr granted David Thomas bearing date 17<sup>th</sup> April 1822 situate on Cole Lick run in Franklin and Jefferson townships in the County of Greene called "Laurel-bluff"
