



Situate in Lower Mahanoy Township in the County of Northumberland on the waters of Mahatongo. Containing Sixty two acres and one hundred and four perches and allowance of six Percent $\frac{1}{2}$ being part of a large tract of land Surveyed unto Peter Troutman the first day of April 1791 by W^m Gray then D.S. by virtue of his warrant dated the 5th day of May 1790 $\frac{1}{2}$. Resurveyed 15th day of June 1827 agreeably to the old and well established line and corners as marked on the ground $\frac{1}{2}$.
