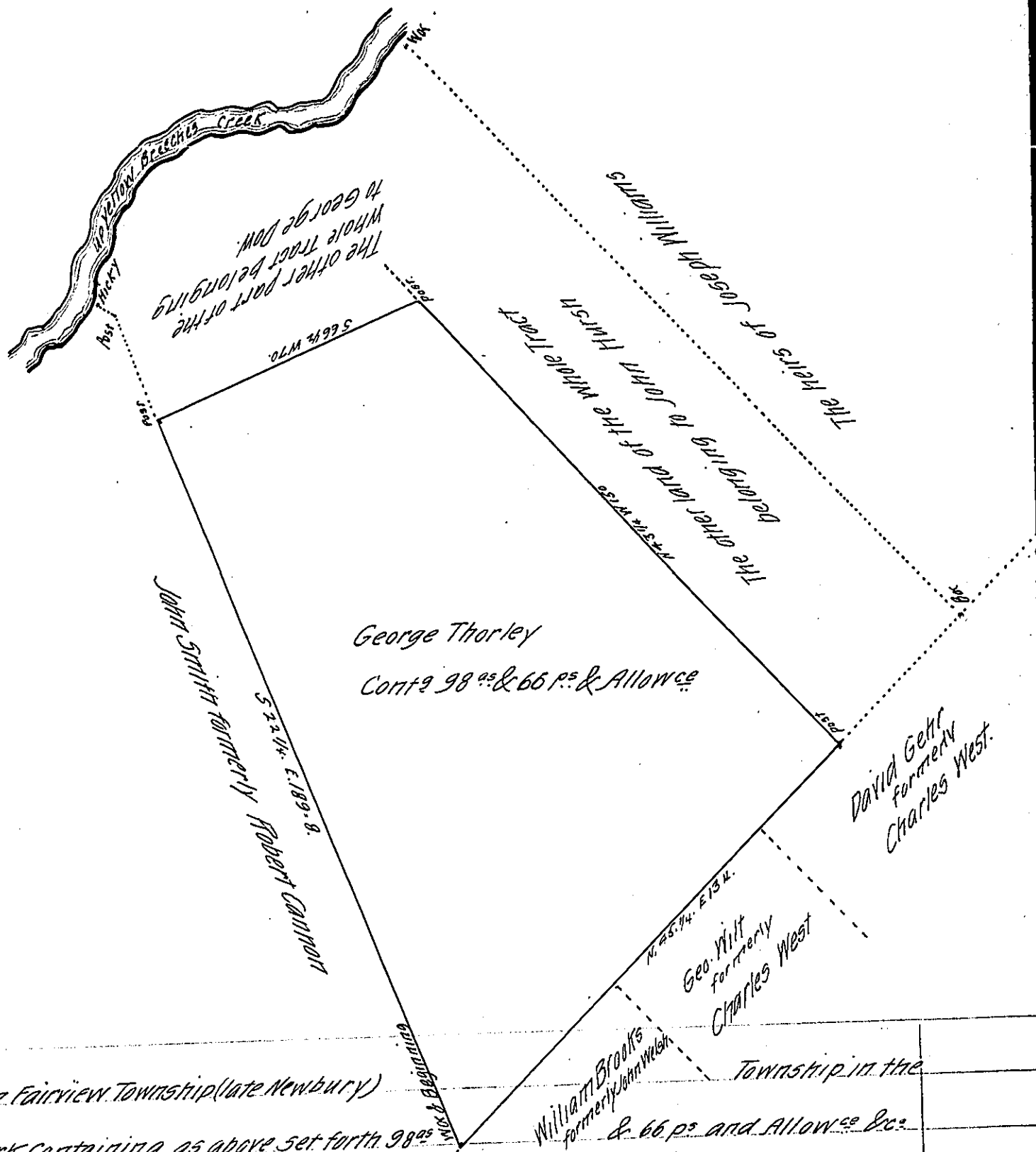

Situate in Fairview Township (late Newbury) County of York containing as above set forth 98<sup>25</sup> & 66 p<sup>5</sup> and Allowance &c. which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the — day of July 1771. In pursuance of Warrant granted to George Thorley bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 1771. — Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1815 for and at the request of the present owner Samuel Thorley who desired that the same should be returned for Confirmation.
