


This tract is a part of a survey made to Thomas Simpson by virtue of his Warrant dated 3<sup>d</sup> November 1785 but has been decided in court in favor of Agness Simpson.

Surveyed to Agness Simpson on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1796 the above described tract containing one hundred and thirty acres and one hundred and eighteen perches and allowance of six p<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads & including an Improvement on the Waters of Cherry Run adjoining land of William McKee and the Heirs of Thomas Simpson in At-Strong now Centre Township. By Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793. By Alexander Taylor for James Ross Esq<sup>e</sup> then D.S. as appears by his Draught in my possession which I have examined and find Correct.
