Resurveyed 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 1799 for Alexander Logan 408 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Acres of land with the allowance of Six per Cent<sup>o</sup> in pursuance of an Order from the Board of Property Bearing date 21<sup>st</sup> of June 1799 which the above Survey includes part of four warrants, viz. 211 Acres, <sup>8 & 6 perches.</sup> part of a Warrant in the Name of William Scull 47 Acres and 153 perches part of a warrant in the name of Jonathan Miller 2 Acres part of a warrant in the name of George Campbell 147 Acres & 41 perches part of a warrant in the name of Joseph McElwaine the warrants bearing 4<sup>th</sup> of March 1793 and Entered in my office the third of September 1794
