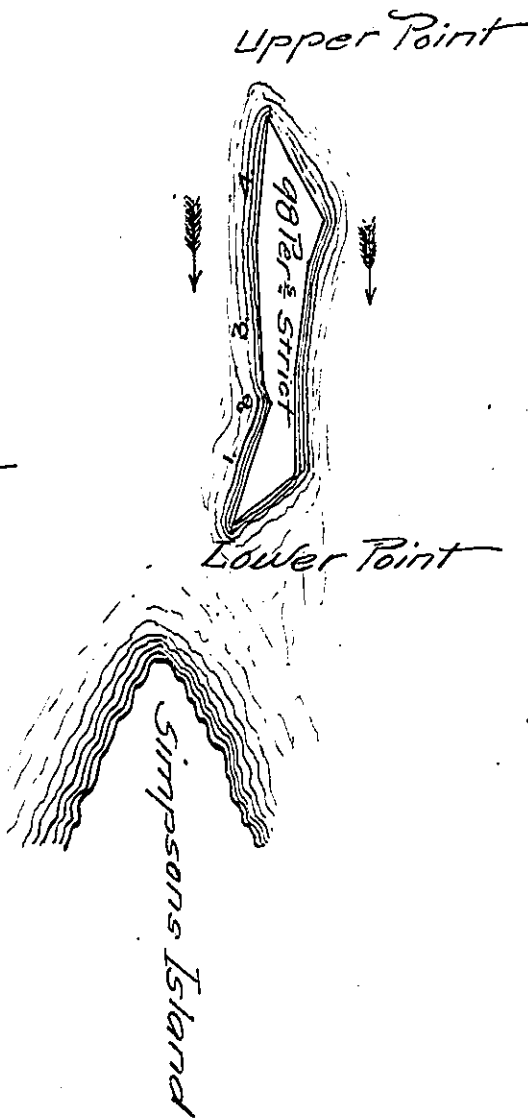

Surveyed July 28<sup>th</sup> 1814 for Jacob Springer the above described Island Situate in the River Susquehanna in Swatara Township about five perches above Simpsons Island, and opposite to lands of Felix Landes & Michael Fleckinger on the Dauphin Shore called "the Bunch of Bunches" containing Ninety five perches Strict by his Warrant of the 27<sup>th</sup> July 1814.
