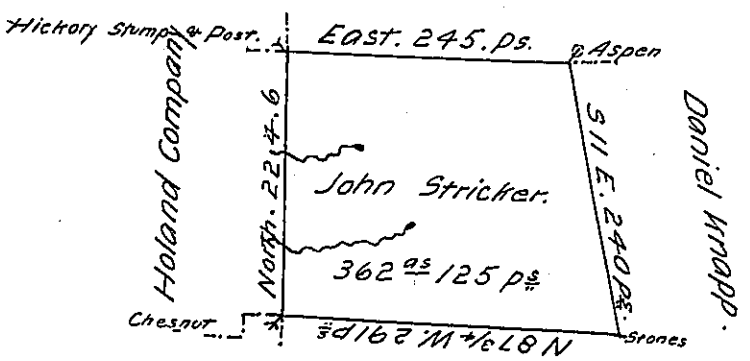

In Pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres Granted to John Stricker dated the 14th of April 1792 was surveyed 29th day of december 1829 for William Gilson the above described tract of land containing 362 acres, 125 perches and allowance of six pr Cent for Roads &c and the said Gilson was Residing on the same & there opened upwards of 20 acres Cleared fenced & in a good state of Cultivation, situate in Oil Creek Township Crawford County Pa.
