



Situate in Washington Township (now Lycoming County) Survey'd the 4th day of November 1809 for Henry Shuler in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 5th day of November 1792. Containing One hundred and seventy six acres & twenty eight perches and Allowance of Six pr. Cent for Roads & C.

N.B. There being a doubt of some other Claim to the land, it was Desired, that the return should not go forward at the time it was made out in December 1809, and nothing appearing to interfere, he now Desires it to be forwarded.
