



Situate on Mohoney creek in West penn township, Schuylkill county containing Fifty two acres and one hundred and thirty one perches and the allowance of Six per Cent it being part of a larger tract of land that was surveyed in pursuance of a proprietary warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1767 granted George Shellhammer and surveyed off for Jacob Leiby on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1826.
